### To become a Master Naturalist:

- > Be over 18 years of age.
- > Enroll in our annual training program for new members.
- ➤ Pay \$30 annual membership fee. An additional \$70 will be due at the start of training to offset training expenses.\*
- > Attend a minimum of 40 hours of the training provided.

### New Member Annual Training:

- Held on Saturdays.
- Class size is limited, spaces reserved on a first come, first serve basis.
- Held at various area locations.

### Certification:

Master Naturalists perform at least 40 hours of volunteer service and complete 8 hours of advanced training within the organization's fiscal year to become and remain certified.
